

## Coconut Coir Potting Mix



One third block of coconut coir  
5 litres of water with 5 mls of Silica added and stirred in  
In a large container put 70% of coir and add 30% of mixture of bark and charcoal  
Add 2 handfuls of Dolomite, water and Silica  
Mix well before potting plants

It is advisable to wash bark before use to get rid of dust and any foreign matter.

Cover the holes in the pot with big pieces of bark before putting in the coir mix.

You can top up the pot with extra bark or stones to help hold the coir mix in place.

If you have a lot of potting, you can use the whole block of coir instead of the smaller amount but you will need to increase the water, silica, dolomite, bark, charcoal etc proportionally.
